The State Support Team provides services and technical assistance to school districts, educational service centers (ESCs), community schools, early childhood centers and families in seven central Ohio counties.

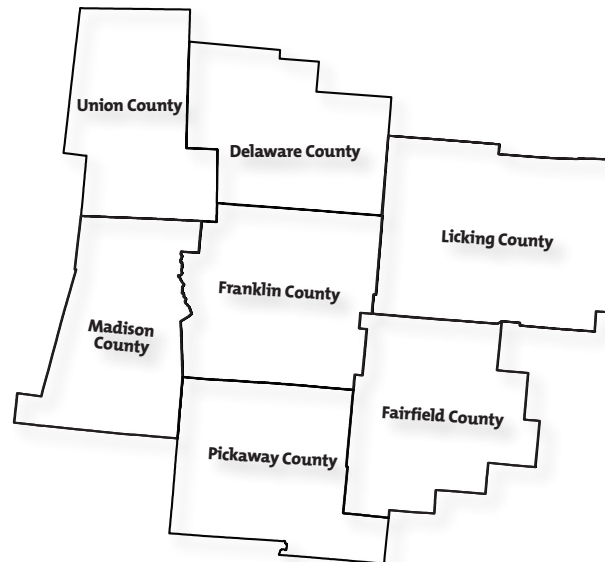

What SST 11 Can Do For Your District

SST 11 staff will partner with school districts or agencies in the implementation of effective internal and external processes to achieve progress in a standards-based education system.

SST staff will support the efforts of school districts to plan, implement and monitor school district improvement, goals and initiatives.

The focus service areas:

- School Improvement
- Special Education Compliance
- Early Learning and School Readiness

The SST supports families by providing technical assistance related to state and federal education initiatives, law and regulations, learning opportunities and surrogate parent training.

School Improvement

SST 11 staff will assist districts in their plans to improve educational outcomes for all students, including students with disabilities, English language learners and at-risk learners.

Ohio is committed to a unified system of support that meaningfully connects early intervention and prevention, early learning and school readiness and special education functions with the work of improving instructional practice and student performance.

Special Education Compliance

The SST focus in this area is driven by Ohio's State Performance Plan, which identifies 20 performance indicators for districts and agencies serving students with disabilities. SST 11 helps districts and community schools improve results for students with disabilities through targeted technical assistance and professional development.

Early Learning and School Readiness

Early Learning and School Readiness focuses on improving outcomes for preschool children with disabilities and supporting early intervening services to children at risk of being identified as disabled. SST staff provides technical assistance and professional development to ensure a seamless pre-kindergarten to third grade system including curriculum, standards, assessments and continuous improvement planning.

Family Services

SST 11 promotes strong family/educator partnerships to enhance the school success for children. SST staff offers information on pertinent issues which impact families of children with disabilities through learning opportunities, technical assistance, consultation and meetings.
