

Alternate Assessment for Students with the Most Significant Cognitive Disability

Course Grade Substitutions

[Ohio Law](#) allows districts and schools to substitute an eligible student’s final course grade in an eligible course for the corresponding high school end-of-course test¹, which includes the Alternate Assessment for Students with the Most Significant Cognitive Disabilities. Using course grades will ensure minimal disruption to a student’s education experience by eliminating the need to take the missed examinations for the purposes of graduation.

Student Eligibility

Students with a most significant cognitive disability are eligible for this course grade substitution in the 2019-2020 school year if they were either:

- Taking a qualifying course *and* scheduled to take the Alternate Assessment for Students with the Most Significant Cognitive Disabilities in the 2019-2020 school year but did not take the test because the administration of the examination was canceled.
- Scheduled to retake the Alternate Assessment for Students with the Most Significant Cognitive Disabilities in the 2019-2020 school year and did not retake the test because the administration of the examination was canceled.

[Ohio Law](#) provides course grade substitution in the 2020-2021 school year for eleventh- and twelfth-grade students.

Course Eligibility

For an eligible student, a qualifying course is any course associated with the [Ohio Learning Standards Extended](#) as listed in the subject areas of this document. Districts should review the course syllabi to ensure it addresses these extended standards. The decision that a course is eligible is made at the local level.
