Most recently, she has translated her expertise in social and emotional learning to the workplace at Chicago Public Schools, where she has provided coaching on emotional intelligence, change management, and employee engagement. Her favorite part of this work has been helping to transform complex ideas into simple, practical tools that solve problems and drive improvement.
