

# Culturally and Historically Responsive Curriculum Evaluation and Practices

Jan. 26, 2022 and Feb. 23, 2022

Educators will learn curricular tools for reviewing and evaluating their curriculum across the academic content areas. They will also practice reviewing and evaluating their curriculum with tools provided. The facilitator will introduce two specific tools for reviewing and evaluating curriculum for culturally and historically responsive education. Participants will take one of their unit plans to review and evaluate. Participants will also have the opportunity to network, learn from colleagues and discuss their observations and findings.
